We must share two areas that we are really excited about. First, the North Andros Bible Institute is starting to take shape. When concluding our second annual Church Leadership Bible Seminar in Lowe Sound, Andros, in February, we held a meeting with all concerned individual. Pastor Larry Wilson from Calvary Baptist Church in Liberty, SC, who will be Dean of Academics, was there and steps were laid out for the finalization. A team of eight teachers and their qualification are being put together along with curriculum and presented to Covington Seminary in Chattanooga, TN. Once approved by them for accreditation we will present the proposal to the Bahamas' Ministry of Education. This could happen as early as this fall.

We had a great time of refreshment at North Florida Baptist Church the last week of February. We count it a privilege and pleasure to not only share with their church family but also the children in their school. Who knows, where the next missionary pilot for the Bahamas will come from.
