To all of our dear co-ministers,

February was an exciting month as the new 2012 school year cranked back up after the kid's six-week summer break. At our home school, little David begins 3rd grade watching and listening to his Pensacola Christian School teacher day by day on DVD. He has the same workbooks as all the kids and pauses the video to do his work. He learned not to push the fast-forward button in first grade! Jamie made sure of that. Jonathan begins 9th grade and wants to be an electrician. He is, therefore, taking electricity as an elective for the remainder of his high school years. He leads our singing on Sunday morning as I am grooming him for ministry of some sort, but it will be up to God to place the high calling upon him. I can't do that. At age 16 Rebecca commences her last year in senior high school, year 12. She turns seventeen in May and wants to be a dental therapist. at least for now. Please pray, if the LORD wills, that she will continue her sign language in university as she already possesses beginning-level skills and communicates with deaf people at her part-time job at a coffee kiosk.

I continue casting the bread of God's Word upon the waters of the Jewish community. During February 286 AD "The Day Yom Kippur Overshadowed Passover books" (now available for free download at our church website) went into mezuzah-marked homes and 1500 gospel tracts sprinkled along the way. We also began a mail-out ministry of these same books to Jewish homes far and wide throughout Melbourne and the state of Victoria. Our goal at Friendship Baptist Church is to reach Hebrews on the horizon where we see but cannot go. We will give a more complete report of this new ministry next month. Please pray for the necessary postage to cover this mail-out project and for the saints within our congregation to completely catch this vision. So far they are enjoying their participation.

Door knocking ministry continues in a neighboring suburb near the church location. Please pray for new Jewish contacts I met and spoke with, one at length named Peter. The others are Michal, Alex, and Elisa. One young Indian man received a New Testament and an illustrated gospel tract and then showed up two Sunday mornings later sitting on the church (school hall) steps. He stated that he was Catholic and had been out of church for some time. I was not there to talk to him and he wasn't sure that he was in the right place, but one godly Indian couple who attends our services assured him that God was directing his paths.

I am writing this letter (March 8) from my childhood home in Kinston, North Carolina. On February 27 I departed Australia (by myself) to come home and attend to my 80-year-old father, Linwood, who needed
