It hardly seems possible that next week Cornerstone Baptist Church in Stanstead, Quebec will celebrate its second anniversary. A lot of hard work has gone into these two years but none of it could be possible without your support. We know what a sacrifice it is to continue giving to missions in this economy and we pray the Lord will bless you for your gift. We wish you could see what a difference you have made in families in Quebec.

Our Wednesday night youth group has continued very strong. We have recently had two new boys that are regularly attending. Please pray for all these young people. We know that our best chance of seeing their parents come to church is through these young people. Often our only chance of building a relationship with their parents are through the minutes we see them as they pick up their young people from the youth group or Sunday School. Also there is a girl who we believe is very convicted and close to accepting Christ. We have tried to make it a habit of having the children come to us instead of approaching them because we don't want them to feel pressured or to profess a salvation that is not real. However this girl is extremely shy. Please pray for Abigail.

Our small group of adults are very faithful. Ron continues to show real growth. Our latest adult to be saved is Carol. In our August letter we asked you to pray for Carol. Carol lives next door to the church and had been faithfully attending and professed to be a Christian. Before Christmas she was helping her children memorize scripture on salvation. She suddenly began to cry and said "I have never done this". She was so excited and could not stop telling everyone how happy she felt and what a weight had been lifted. She probably has the strongest testimony in the community and it showed in visitors coming due to her testimony. In the last few weeks Carol has been through a great deal. She has continued to have weekly meetings for discipleship but has been unable to attend church at times. Please pray for Carol! She is very dear to our heart. The stress shows on her face and in her children.

Also please pray for more adult visitors. We see a change in everybody from the border crossing guards to the community. They are much more friendly and accepting of us. They are quick to voice that they really appreciate what we are doing for the children of the community. We are very appreciative of this but would like the adults to see their need also.

We have just finished a Sunday night series on the history of the Bible for English speaking people. It was very well attended. It was new material for everyone at church to learn.

Thank you for praying for my back surgery. Things went very well but some of my symptoms remain. I am still having Physical Therapy.

In April the McElroys will be going to Wisconsin for several weeks. Please pray for their safety and for us as we try to handle the youth group and Church without them.
