National FFA Expo Update

Many of you have requested an update on the situation with the FFA Expo that we have got into in the past year. Here is the latest. After spending months chasing down who made the decision and who can change it, I found that the Dept of Education in Washington D.C. has GREAT control over the FFA. Without giving all the details, when it came down to putting the blame on them and their appointees on the FFA Board of Directors, they called the FFA and the CEO just wrote me a letter and said “*they (Dept of Ed) did not participate in the decision...*” Now after 11.5 months of telling us, first, the Dept of Ed, then ‘we don’t want any religious booths’ to now saying they had ‘complaints...about alleged harassment and threats’ made by our people! We are continuing to press this issue and I am now asking if you would please write to this man and tell him you disagree with his decision. Also, if you are in anyway associated with the FFA either as a parent of a FFA member or a teacher involved with the FFA I strongly urge you to write him. Please remember though, you are representing Jesus Christ in your letter.

I am also asking you to join with me on the days of the National FFA Expo, October 24-27 to fast and pray for this situation! As a reminder all fast’s do not have to be from food only. You can fast from TV, News, Internet, Social Media, etc. and of course extra Bible reading helps also. Foreign Report

Philippines: The work is progressing, but at a cost. We are experiencing repairs on our vehicles. Of the two vans used in this work one is in need of just under \$1000. work on it. We also are looking to buy another van to expand the work on the island of Cebu. This will cost between \$4,000- \$6000.

Liberia: After taking a break during the rainy season there, we have many works planned the remainder of the year. Pray also as Pastor Quapourlee is trying to come to the US for our AGM Conference in Feb. Pray it comes thru.

Togo Pastor Kodjo Kavi and wife Dede have had their baby! A Boy! Pray for this new family!

Benin: Pastor Babalola has another worker in his country so the results are growing. We love to see the Lord grow His work.

Nigeria: Thomas Adesoye is back from his trip to Uganda. We have two solid workers there now. And just as importantly, we eliminated one we thought would be a good one. PTL for His direction.

Ghana: Pastor Orus has reported more good numbers.

Camaroon: Pastor Jonathan is a faithful worker. He has received the funds YOU sent for his motorbike. Here is a picture of him with his bike.



If you remember, we added many local workers in Africa. These all did great, but have been dropping out over time. In discussion with the African Director, he feels like the cost of travel for these men and other costs that come up, are leading them not to go with the 3 door units and do the work. I asked for an estimate of what those costs would be and who would be worthy of this help. Here is the list of workers and their needs.

The different amounts are because of differing costs in different areas

If you feel the Lord leading to support one of these workers, send to the office and they will get it.

And in the Philippines, **we need a van** purchased for the island of Cebu. The cost of a used van runs **\$4000 to \$6000**.

And we have **repairs on the van** we have on Mindanao Island for 50,000 PHP which is **\$928** at today's exchange rate. Please do as the Lord leads you to give toward these projects.

Also, we just **repaired the machine** that puts the tabs on this prayer letter and it was **\$1359**. If you can help us with these costs we would be thankful.
