We have been with Macedonia World Baptist Missions for thirty-four years and many of you have been with us for the entire time. Thank God for your faithfulness. As I looked at the news toward the end of the year many stations reported the year in review and highlighted the major news stories for the past year. I decided to look at our year in review. This past year I preached in fourteen churches and one rescue ministry. We saw nine professions of faith in services and personal soul winning in 2017. Many other victories and decisions were made. She hasn't slept well for many years and was diagnosed with sleep apnea in Dec. 2016. She got her CPAP machine in Feb. 2017. She still is not sleeping well and after many different masks that all leaked she is so tired and discouraged about the whole situation. She wakes up all through the night and gets up tired and it is not getting better. Please pray for my wife. I am not ready to start a new rescue ministry over 400 miles from our home with her in that condition. I am anxious to go but her health is so important and she is so important to our ministry. 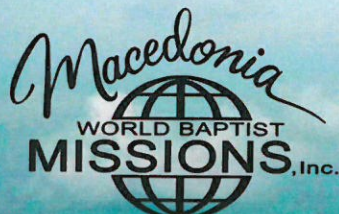
