They wanted us to help them find their next pastor and we advertised the opening through e-mail. We had several applicants to call me and I screened each one asking personal and doctrinal questions. So many churches get in a hurry and call men not knowing what they believe or what their past ministry has been. He answered all the doctrinal questions Biblically correct, and after meeting them, I believe he and his wife live what he preaches. I was impressed by this young couple and I hope they call him as their next Pastor.

Lord willing we will be home in Georgia until after Christmas. We don't get to spend many Holidays with our family and we are looking forward to Thanksgiving and Christmas with some of our kids and grandkids. She still isn't sleeping well with her sleep apnea and that has been going on for some time. She has tried several different masks but none work good. The sleep apnea people don't seem too interested in helping her. She doesn't complain, but lack of sleep will take a toll on the body. I am doing fine with a minor surgery on my hand. I am typing this letter and all fingers are working well.

Thank you all for your prayers and financial support. We couldn't help these churches and not get a salary without your help.
