It is always a concern when missionary goes away, gets sick, or hospitalized that his work in ministry goes on. The following are the results of my ministry and team's efforts at the flea market in my absence. 4740 tract packs were given out to people. 145 actual witnessing opportunities where my team were able to sit down with the person and present the Gospel. Out of this number 13 professions of faith were made. 53 King James Bibles were given to those who asked for them. 37 New Testaments were given. 63 Spanish Bibles were given to those who asked for them. 19 Navajo Bibles were given to those Dinyeh who demonstrated the ability read and understand the Navajo language. 33 Children's Bible story books were given out. Beside the Bibles and tract packs there were many Bible related books given out: 50 Bible Promise books, these are usually given along with Bibles given out. 25 John Wesley's book on Prayer were given out. 45 Know Your Bible books were given out. 100 Daily Bread devotional books were also given out. I was laid up for 6 months but my ministry kept going as the Gospel went out and people were saved. Praise the Lord!!

Please pray for my continued recovery. I am home but I am still being visited by different therapists that are helping adapt and get stronger. Pray that I can continue get stronger and that I will be able continue in ministry as soon as I am able and in the Lord's timing and will. God bless!
